## **GREENBRAE HILLS NEIGHBORHOOD RESPONSE GROUP *IT TAKES A VILLAGE!***

After a large earthquake, emergency services will be overwhelmed. We need to be prepared to take care of ourselves for the first few days. Larkspur and nearby communities have created a network of Neighborhood Response Groups (NRGs) for this purpose.

Greenbrae Hills is divided into 7 NRGs, each made up of blocks of 10-20 homes. Each block should have 2-3 volunteer block captains. After taking care of their own families in the event of a real earthquake, Block Captains will walk their block of homes and look for your OK/HELP sign in your window. If you don't need help, post "OK" and your block captain will move on. If you do need help, post "HELP", and your block captain will radio into a central command where volunteer Community Emergency Response Teams (CERT) and other volunteer medical staff will be mobilizing. Drills are held twice per year (on Daylight Savings days) to test radio equipment and practice response preparedness. Get involved!

**This program is run by volunteers who are your neighbors. The "BIG ONE" is overdue, and we need volunteers to:**

- Learn to be Block Captain organizers
- Get first aid (FADR) and CERT training
- Know how to use our radio system
- Participate in drills and social events
